Dress Code/Uniform Notes

1/4 zip sweatshirts are special ordered by each shop in which they are offered

None of the Transportation Academies requires a shop kit

All shops may select blue or grey versions of each available FCCTC item unless otherwise listed

Level 1 students have a one week grace period to be in uniform. Returning students should be in uniform on Day 1

Students experiencing financial instability should inquire in the counselling office about our Alumni Association scholarships

General Dress Code Requirements

All Transportation Academy students must wear a FCCTC t-shirt as their base layer

Appropriate student dress always includes the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as explained by the teacher.

Outerwear (sweatshirts, hoodies, flannels, etc) must be FCCTC items, with the exception of heavy coats for working outside

Students must arrive to FCCTC in uniform. Students may change before leaving for a school event (sports, etc)

FCCTC items may not be modified in any way (removing sleeves, adding graphics, etc)

Students are not permitted to wear clothing with holes/frays/tears/patches

Shorts, skirts, and dresses are not permitted
